- No applications will be accepted after December 31, 2015
- If player pays by cheque, all cheques must be cleared by the bank first.
- Both Current and New player must be paid in full before a cheque can be issued to player.
- If the new member requests a refund, the rebate and administration fee will be deducted from the new member's refund.
- It will be up to the refunded player to arrange for the rebate issued be reimbursed to them from the existing player
- New players also include Siblings who have not played with Lorne Park.
- Siblings who have taken the sibling discount will only qualify for \$20.00 rebate
